

MONTECASINO INSTALLS BARCO 3D PROJECTOR

5 March 2008 - 3D cinema has come to NuMetro Montecasino with the installation of a Barco 2k digital cinema projector by Questek Advanced Technologies.

The D-Cine Premiere DP100 digital projector delivers 2048 by 1080 display resolution and exceeds the American-based Society of Motion Picture Engineers screen brightness standards on screens up to 20m wide. Using Texas Instruments DLP cinema technology the DP100's integrated light path and digital processing ensures optimum performance and reliability.

The DP100 digital projector contains a hermetically sealed DMD engine that makes maintenance easy and increases the longevity of the product. The triple lamp power system has a backup to ensure that if one power supply fails the display is not affected.

The first 3D screening at NuMetro Montecasino has been Hannah Montana and U2 3D – bringing the energy and excitement of rock group U2's Vertigo South American concert to local audiences.
