A Re Yeng, the City of Tshwane's rapid transit system is committed to providing and ensuring a high quality, customer-orientated bus service that delivers fast, comfortable and low-cost urban mobility for everyone from scholars, pensioners and corporate commuters.

Powered by Vix's open payments system, A Re Yeng uses bank issued contactless LVP cards for convenient urban mobility.

During the interim phase of the project, Vix-Questek together with its consortium partner, Xtremetec Management will commission the AFC payments scheme.

The transition from a traditional transit operator self-managed back-end system to a payment system run in co-operation with a financial institution enables a convenient payment solution for passengers, lower capital costs for the City with increased system reliability and security.

Further system enhancements will include card vending machines, mobile ticket offices, new bus routes and new gated bus stations which will transform the way passengers connect and commute in the City of Tshwane.
